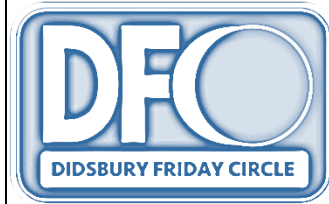


# Didsbury Friday Circle

## Brief Report of Session

After making our introductions, we continued the session on the persecution in Mecca of the early Muslims, how severe this was, by whom it was undertaken and why. We then described how the Prophet (SAW) directed some of the companions to migrate to Abyssinia, including the reasons for the migration. We again covered the great king of Abyssinia (The Negus), and the prominent sahaba who went to Abyssinia. We also covered here how Quraish responded to the migration by chasing the Muslims to Abyssinia and attempting to take them back for punishment.

We split the boys into teams to get them to build a Mosque using paper, straws and tape. Their creativity, engineering and architectural skills were displayed. After the mosques were built, a short reminder was given about the importance of the heart of the mosque being the people inside it.
